- Announce Game Play by Play or do Color Commentary for Cable Access Channel
- Run the time and score clock.
- Serve as a volunteer referee (there will be 3 WIAA officials at all games)
- Help Organize the Candy Bar Fundraiser for Parents Day
- Serve on fund raising activity committee
- EMT/Medic or Nurse for game day to be at the field
- Run Chains and Down Markers at games
- Post Game Clean up for the grounds following home games
- Work in the snack stand at home games
- Distribute Programs at Home Games
- Help with Equipment Distribution at Parent Night or Equipment Return Night

FOR THE 2008 RAPIDS RAPTOR FOOTBALL SEASON, EVERY FAMILY WILL BE REQUIRED TO WORK A MINIMUM OF 5 VOLUNTEER HOURS. THESE HOURS CAN BE WORKED IN AN ASSORTMENT OF AREAS BOTH PRIOR TO AND ON GAME DAY.
